ITINARY

DAY 1 : MONTREAL / PARIS

Departure from Montreal-Trudeau airport to Paris with AIR TRANSAT or any other company member of IATA.

DAY 2: PARIS

Arrival in Paris and welcoming by a local guide. Transfer to the hotel after a brief introduction to Paris: les Champs Élysées, l'Arc de Triomphe, la Place du Trocadéro. Dinner and night at the hotel. (D)

DAY 3: PARIS

After breakfast, the morning begins with the spectacular Audio Visual Tour « Paristory » followed by a classic panoramic guided tour. We will see la Place de la Concorde, les Invalides, the Latin Quarter, the Louvre, Notre Dame Cathedral, la Place de la Bastille. Afternoon you are free to visit the sights at your leisure. Your guide will provide you with all the essentials Paris

can offer! Dinner. Return to hotel later that day. (B-D)

DAY 4 : PARIS / ROUEN

After breakfast, day of discovery in the Region of Perche : St Langis, Mortagne, Autheuil, La Gagnognière, La Ventrouze, Randonnai, Bresolettes and Tourouvre. The principal sites of interest are the ancestral home called “La Chauvelière” at the north of the village, where Pierre Rivard, father of Nicolas and Robert lived. The church itself, which was supported and sustained by the family and is full of historical elements and the enclosed cemetery which is believed to be the source of the dit name Lavigne (the vine). Visit the Courcière farm, in nearby Bons-Moulins. Presentation by the Museum of Canadian Emigration with documents and archives concerning the emigrants from Perche. Transfer towards Rouen. Arrival to the hotel in the capital of Haute-Normandie. Dinner at your leisure. Night at hotel (B-L)

DAY 5: ROUEN / GIVERNY

After breakfast, discover Rouen, capital of Haute-Normandie. Home of Corneille and writer Gustave Flaubert with magnificent Gothic churches. In the old town, we discover medieval streets, old wooden homes, l'Église St-Maclou, the Big clock, the courthouse and the market place where Joan of Arc was burned. In the afternoon we visit ruins of the Château-Gaillard with its fabulous view of la Seine and travel to Giverny where Claude Monet lived from 1883 to 1926. Visit the famous pink house with green shutters, where Monet painted. The house was restored to its original state to reflect the time when the master of impressionism was creating. Return to Rouen for dinner and night at the hotel. (B-D)

DAY 6: ROUEN / HONFLEUR / CAEN

After breakfast, we will travel towards the ocean to reach Honfleur, the town from which Samuel de Champlain left to reach Nouvelle France. You will discover Ste-Catherine's church, the largest wooden church of France built by ship builders, the old port and the Satie's house. Then on to Caen to the Castle of William the Conqueror, the Abbey of men and women. Dinner and night. (B-D)



DAY 7: THE BEACHES OF NORMANDIE

After breakfast, we spend the day visiting the beaches of Normandie. Stop and ponder the Canadian Cemetery Beny-Sur-Mer, then Courseulles-sur-mer where the marine infantry landed on beaches known as coded name; Sword, Omaha Beach, Arromanches and Juno Beach where the prestigious regiment from La Chaudiere landed. Visit the Canadian Centre of Juno Beach, Arromanches, Port-en-Bessin, etc. Dinner and return to Caen for the night. (B-D)



DAY 8: CAEN / LE MONT ST-MICHEL / ST MALO

After breakfast, depart for Mont St. Michel. Justly called the eighth wonder of the world, the Mont is a true masterpiece of architecture. The structure floats on the incoming tide like a phantom cathedral off in the distant sky. The legend of Mont St. Michel was born of an apparition of the Archangel St. Michel one night in 708 commanding the Archbishop of Avranches to build a church on the Mont. Following a tidal wave, the surrounding land was inundated isolating the mont in the sea. It was thereafter baptised Mont St. Michel and became an important destination for pilgrims. In the middle ages it was the most fabulous edifice ever built by the monastic order, an architectural feat that defined the prowess of the Church. The surrounding bay extends 23 kilometers, the rising tide is said to rush in at the speed of a horse at full gallop. Visit the abbey at your leisure. In the afternoon, transfert towards St-Malo, la Cité Corsaire where Samuel de Champlain departed for Nouvelle France, and where the local artists strive to capture the unique atmosphere of the city. Hotel and Dinner.(B-D)

DAY 9: ST-MALO

After breakfast, discovering of St-Malo. Walk the old streets and the ramparts of la Porte St Vincent, the Bidouane Tower, les Bastions St-Louis where you will have an amazing view on the port and the beautiful houses. The high tide will bring an even more spectacular show. Free time to discover treasures of the Cité malouine. Dinner at a creperie and night at the hotel. (B-D)

DAY 10: ST-MALO / NANTES / LA ROCHELLE

After breakfast, depart for Nantes. Enjoy a city tour including the "DUKES OF BRITAIN " castle. Early afternoon arrive in La Rochelle, an historic and architectural jewel. Visit the Towers of St-Nicolas, the Lanterne and the Old Quarter, where one can see the luxurious home of Henry 11. Lodging at hotel. Dinner. Night at hotel. (B-D)

DAY 11 : BROUAGES/FORT BOYARD/L'ILE de RE

After breakfast, discover the fortified city of Brouage. Your guide will share with you all the great history of this beautiful place. Departing from Port de Fouras, the early afternoon will lead you on a 1¼ hr cruise around Fort Boyard. The bridge will be our way to leave the continent and reach l'Île de Ré and St-Martin-De-Ré. Return to La Rochelle in late afternoon. Dinner and night at the hotel. (B-D)

DAY 12 : LA ROCHELLE/TOURS

After breakfast, enjoy the beginning of your day and discover the beautiful city of La Rochelle. You will even have the possibility to run your own genealogical research in the city archives. In the afternoon, departure for Tours. Check in at the hotel and sightseeing of the old town where you will find the St-Gatien Cathedral, St Julien church, Plumereau Place and beautiful houses of past centuries. Dinner. Lodging at hotel. (B-D)

DAY 13: CHENONCEAUX/AMBOISE

After breakfast, transfer towards Chenonceaux and visit the « Château des Dames » and its magnificent structure over the Cher. You will be amazed! Then, we travel to Amboise and admire the Loire. Wine tasting in Touraine. The day ends with an incomparable visit to the Ursuline

Convent where Marie de l'Incarnation, the first teacher who came to Quebec City on August 1, 1639, is honored and remembered. Dinner. (B-D)

DAY 14: CHAMBORD / VERSAILLES

After breakfast, discover the exterior of a Chambord Castle, a grandiose creation of Francois the first and the largest of the Loire Castles. This impressive white architecture creates a strong sense of beauty and strength. On our way back, we stop at Versailles and visit the Château of Louis XIV Le Roi Soleil, the grand apartments and the spectacular manicured gardens with reflecting pools and gardens. Late afternoon arrival in Paris. Check in to the Hotel. Dinner & lodging at the hotel. (B-D)

DAY 15: PARIS

After breakfast, enjoy the day to discover some of the city's most magnificent museums or take time to loiter in well-known boutiques. In late afternoon, transfer to Montmartre for an evening of entertainment and dinner. Transportation and cocktails included. Before returning to the hotel, the bateau-mouche will welcome you to navigate the Seine and experience the Lights of Paris.(B)

A valid passport is required.

TO RESERVE :
